**ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PROPOSED REPORT AND ORDER**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Joint Motion for Extension of Time* (“motion”) in part. In the motion, the parties ask the Commission to extend the time for filing the proposed report and order on these applications,<sup>1</sup> with a supporting memorandum. Those filings were due on May 30<sup>2</sup> in accordance with the parties’ proposed procedural schedule<sup>3</sup> and the parties ask for an extension to June 7.

In support of the motion, the parties plead the press of business, including actions pending before the Commission and in the Court of Appeals for review of Commission decisions. Those actions were known to the parties when they filed their proposed procedural schedule. And extensions of the schedule necessarily delay the Commission’s decision.



2. The date for filing a joint proposed report and order, and supporting memorandum, is extended to June 6, 2013.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
