ORDER RECOGNIZING PARTIES

On March 10, 2020, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro (Evergy Metro) filed its 2020 annual update of the Integrated Resource Plan it first presented to the Commission in its 2018 triennial IRP filing in File No. EO-2018-0268. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.020(56) defines “Stakeholder Group” as including any entity granted intervention in a prior Chapter 22 proceeding of the electric utility. That regulation also provides that such entities are to be parties to any subsequent related Chapter 22 proceeding of the electric utility without the necessity of applying to intervene in the subsequent case. The Commission will therefore recognize that the parties to File No. EO-2018-0268 are parties to this case.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties to File No. EO-2018-0268 are recognized as parties to this case.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.

¹ The Missouri Department of Natural Resources -Division of Energy and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group have filed applications to intervene in this case. Since both entities were parties in EO-2018-0268, they are recognized as parties by this order. Their applications to intervene are superfluous and will not be further addressed.


