Purpose:

Compliance Filing in Case No. GR-2001-292

On October 1, 2001, Missouri Gas Energy, A division of Southern Union Company (MGE or Company) filed tariff sheets bearing a proposed effective date of November 1, 2001.

These tariffs were filed to comply with the Commission's Order Approving Second Revised Stipulation and Agreement (Order). This Order provides that MGE should be authorized to receive a revenue increase in the amount of \$9,892,228 exclusive of funding for the experimental low-income rate proposed in the stipulation and agreement, and exclusive of gross receipts taxes or taxes or fees of a similar nature. The stipulation and agreement contains numerous other provisions to resolve disputed issues between the parties, including a provision requiring that MGE's Experimental Low Income Rate (ELIR) should go into effect no later than November 1, 2001. The provisions in this tariff are the result of extensive discussions and consensus among MGE, Staff, and the Office of Public Counsel.

The Commission's Energy Department Staff has reviewed this filing and is unaware of any issue currently pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing. Staff is of the opinion that good cause exists for approval of these tariff sheets. Staff therefore recommends approval of the following tariff sheets, as filed on October 1, 2001 with an effective date of November 1, 2001:
