The tariff sheets listed below issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company) was filed as a revision of Schedule No. 6, Schedule of Rates for Electricity, on June 4, 2025:

Original Sheet No. 34.1

This tariff sheet is being issued June 4, 2025, to become effective on and after July 4, 2025.

The proposed tariff sheet modifies Ameren Missouri's service territory records in New Madrid County. NextEra is constructing a solar facility in portions of seven sections of the county and will be interconnected directly to the adjacent Ameren Missouri transmission system. Six of the sections are already identified in Ameren Missouri Schedule No. 6 Sheet No. 34 as being in Company's service territory. The seventh section (16) is not separable from the transmission point of interconnection. Ameren Missouri and the developer discussed serving the project with Associated Electric Cooperative and Pemiscot-Dunklin Cooperative and both cooperatives declined to enter into a partial territorial agreement. However, Ameren Missouri does not expect the cooperatives to oppose this filling to include the portion of Section 16 occupied by the solar facility.
