MOTION TO DIRECT FILING AND JOINT LIST OF ISSUES, LIST AND ORDER OF WITNESSES, ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION, AND ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and on behalf of The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"), the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), the City of Joplin ("Joplin"), the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy ("DE"), and the Midwest Energy Users' Association ("MEUA") (collectively the "parties"), with the exception of Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), tenders this Motion to Direct Filing and Joint List of Issues, List and Order of Witnesses, Order of Cross Examination, and Order of Opening Statements in satisfaction of the Commission's Order Setting Procedural Schedule issued herein on August 20, 2014, and moves for an order of the Commission directing MECG to specifically identify which issues it disputes with the other parties and identify which witnesses it wishes to cross-examine on each such issue.

All parties to this proceeding, with the exception of MECG, have reached an agreement in principle as to all issues in this rate case proceeding and intend to file a global stipulation and agreement with the Commission by Friday, April 3, 2015. It is the

understanding of these parties that MECG will object to the global stipulation and agreement to be filed by all other parties to the case and request a hearing. At this time, the parties present a list of all matters at issue in this rate case proceeding. To avoid unnecessary witness appearances and the unnecessary expenditure of the Commission's time and the parties' resources, the parties to the global settlement agreement request that MECG be directed to make the filing described above. This will allow for a more appropriate List of Issues, List and Order of Witnesses, and Order of Cross Examination to be filed with the Commission.¹
