#### ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STAFF REPORT

Issue Date: May 29, 2020 Effective Date: May 29, 2020

On April 15, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2019 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and RES Compliance Plan for the calendar years 2020 through 2022,<sup>1</sup> as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8). Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to review RES compliance reports and plans and file a report of its review with the Commission within 45 days of the date of filing; paragraph (E) of the same rule allows the Office of the Public Counsel and other interested persons or entities to file comments, also within the same 45 days. May 30, 2020, is 45 days from the filing date of April 15, 2020.

On May 29, 2020, Staff filed a *Staff Report and Motion for Extension of Time*. Staff indicates it has completed its review of Ameren's RES Compliance Plan and found no deficiencies. However, Staff advises Ameren is in the process of responding to Staff's inquiries about deficiencies in Ameren's RES Compliance Report. Staff requests an

extension to no later than June 12, 2020,<sup>2</sup> to file its report on Ameren's RES Compliance Report.

The Commission finds Staff's request for additional time to be reasonable and will grant the request.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- Staff shall file its report regarding Ameren's 2019 Renewable Energy
   Standard Compliance Report no later than June 12, 2020.
- 2. The Office of the Public Counsel and any other interested person or entity may file reports concerning Ameren's 2019 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report no later than June 12, 2020.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
