NOTICE OF HEARING AND ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 16, 2020, Claude Scott filed a complaint with the Commission against Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire. On May 11, 2020, the Commission held a prehearing conference in this matter. On June 4, 2020, the Commission's Staff submitted a joint proposed procedural schedule. The Commission will adopt the following procedural schedule and establish the time and place for evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The following procedural schedule is established:
 - Last day to request discovery June 22, 2020
 - Stipulation of undisputed facts July 17, 2020
 - Issues, exhibit and witness lists July 20, 2020
 - Evidentiary hearing July 24, 2020
 - Post-hearing briefs – if ordered August 14, 2020
- Based on the parties' agreement, pre-filed testimony will not be used at hearing.

3. An evidentiary hearing shall be held on **July 24, 2020**, at:

The hearing shall begin at **10:30 a.m.** All parties shall appear.

4. The hearing location meets the accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 5. **In the event the Commission determines an in-person hearing is not feasible because of COVID-19 restrictions or for any other reason, the hearing will be conducted by teleconference at 10:30 a.m. July 24, 2020.** Dial-in instructions for the teleconference will be provided in a future order, if necessary.
