STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion for Extension of Time to File Report* in this matter hereby states:

1. In relation to a working docket ordered by the Commission December 2, 2015, regarding the policy and regulatory issues presented by electric vehicle charging stations, Staff conducted a workshop May 25, 2016. The workshop sparked lengthy debate and presented a wealth of information regarding electric vehicle charging stations and related points of interest. Following the workshop, the interested parties have continued to file comments and documents relating to the topic for Staff to include in consideration for its Final Report.

2. Due to the additional information Staff has received from the docket, it has identified further information and analysis necessary for inclusion in its report. To that end, Staff requests a new filing date of August 1, 2016 for its recommendation, and a date of October 1, 2016 for responses of any person or entity wishing to file.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will grant this request for an extension to August 1, 2016 for Staff's report and October 1, 2016 for the response of all other parties; and grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just in the circumstances.
