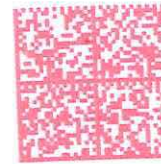

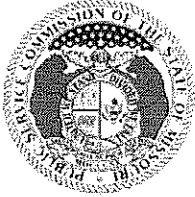

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties in the most recent general rate case for each of Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities. (Ameren Missouri ER-2016-0179, KCP&L ER-2016-0285, KCPL-GMO ER-2016-0156, and Empire ER-2016-0023)
2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the news media and to the members of the General Assembly.
3. A workshop meeting will be held on November 20, 2017, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in Room 450 (Ballroom) at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison St., Jefferson City, MO 65102. A second workshop meeting will be held on January 9, 2018, from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. in Room 450 (Ballroom) at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison St., Jefferson City, MO 65102.
4. Interested parties are invited to provide information to Staff before the workshop meeting. Such information may be provided directly to Staff, or may be filed in this file. Such information should be submitted by October 20, 2017.
5. Staff shall submit its report regarding distributed energy resources no later than March 1, 2018.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.




