This office represents the following small rural telephone companies (Small Companies) who provide telecommunications service in the state of Missouri:

For the period beginning March, 2001 through April, 2005, T-Mobile USA (formerly VoiceStream) terminated wireless originated calls to the exchanges served by these Small Companies. These Small Companies issued bills to T-Mobile for this wireless traffic in accordance with their respective Wireless Termination Service Tariffs which were on file with and approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission for this period. However, T-Mobile has repeatedly refused to pay for the tariffed charges associated with this terminating


