ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING AN INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING

Issue Date: July 1, 2025 Effective Date: July 1, 2025

On June 27, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage an electric generating facility to be constructed in Jefferson County, Missouri. Ameren Missouri proposes building an 800-megawatt multi-unit simple cycle natural gas electric generation facility with fuel oil backup capability at the former site of Ameren Missouri's coal-fired Rush Island Energy Center.

Ameren Missouri's application also asks Commission approval of a 400-megawatt battery storage facility to be built on the Rush Island site in addition to the natural gas electric generation facility.

Ameren Missouri is requesting Commission approval of the proposed facilities by March of 2026.

Ameren Missouri also requests a variance from the requirement in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.045(6)(J) to allow it to submit an overview of its plans for restoration

of safe and adequate service after significant unplanned outages 60 days after the time when each facility is placed in-service.

The requested CCN would allow Ameren Missouri to construct, finance, and operate the proposed generation and battery storage facilities.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests. The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a pleading stating when it can submit a report.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Jefferson County, Missouri.
- 2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice available to the newspapers and other media serving Ameren Missouri's Missouri service areas.
- 3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than July 21, 2025. Such application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System.
- 4. The Commission's Staff shall file a pleading no later than July 14, 2025, stating a date certain that Staff can file a report about this CCN request.
 - 5. This order shall be effective when issued.
