## UNOPPOSED MOTION TO SET LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS, DIRECT NOTICE, AND EXTEND STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW, the Office of the Public Counsel (the "OPC") and requests that the Commission set two local public hearings for this matter—one virtual and another in Altenburg, Missouri—direct notice of the local public hearings, and extend the deadline for Staff to file its Recommendation. In support, the OPC states as follows:

- 1. On May 1, 2025, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") filed an Application and supporting Direct Testimony requesting the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (the "Commission") issue a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") for ATXI to "construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a new, approximately four-mile, 138-kV transmission line and associated facilities in Perry County, Missouri." (Appl. 1, Doc. 2). ATXI requested that the Commission issue an order on its Application no later than March 1, 2026. (*Id.*).
- 2. On May 2, 2025, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice, Setting Intervention Deadline, and Directing Staff Recommendation (the "Order").

- (Doc. 8). In the Order, the Commission directed Staff to file a Recommendation regarding ATXI's Application or a request for additional time no later than July 31, 2025. (Order 2).
- The OPC believes that local public hearings would be beneficial in this matter, particularly so that all parties and the Commission may hear from affected landowners.
- 4. The OPC has conferred with ATXI and the Staff of the Commission ("Staff," and collectively with ATXI and the OPC, the "Parties") and neither ATXI nor Staff oppose this request.
- 5. The Parties have conferred regarding available dates, times, and locations for the local public hearings. The Parties respectfully offer the following for the Commission's consideration:

6. The OPC also requests that the Commission direct its Data Center to provide a copy of the order setting the local public hearings to the County Commission of Perry County, to the members of the General Assembly representing Perry County, and to the news media serving Perry County. In addition, the OPC requests that the Commission order ATXI to provide notice to all individuals who own property within 750 feet of the centerline of the proposed route for the project,<sup>2</sup> as stated in

(Spurlock Direct Test. 3, Doc. 5). ATXI also states that it may need to deviate from the route proposed in the Application "within the 600-foot-wide

the records of the county assessor's office for Perry County. The OPC further

requests that this notice be sent via physical mail to be postmarked no later than 10

business days prior to the local public hearings and via electronic notification to all

individuals for whom ATXI has contact information (either email or text message)

no later than three days before the local public hearings.

7. Because the dates for the proposed local public hearings are beyond the date

currently set for Staff's Recommendation, the OPC respectfully requests that the

Commission extend the deadline for Staff to file its Recommendation to September

15, 2025. Counsel for Staff and ATXI have advised counsel for the OPC that

neither Staff nor ATXI oppose this request.

WHEREFORE, the OPC respectfully requests that the Commission set the local public

hearings as identified above, order that notice be provided as detailed above, extend the time for

Staff to file its Recommendation, and for any other relief deemed necessary and appropriate by the

Commission.
