ORDER APPROVING DEMAND SIDE INVESTMENT MECHANISM RIDER RATE ADJUSTMENT TARIFFS

Issue Date: July 14, 2025 Effective Date: August 1, 2025

On June 2, 2025, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively, Evergy) filed tariffs, with supporting testimony, to adjust charges related to their approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) Rider under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA). The tariffs were assigned Tracking No. JE-2025-0171 and JE-2025-0172, and they have an effective date of August 1, 2025.

The Commission issued notice of the filing, set an intervention deadline, and directed the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to submit recommendations. On July 2, 2025, Staff recommended the Commission approve the tariffs in both cases. No responses or objections were received to either the tariffs or Staff's recommendation.

Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4) and 20 CSR 4240-3.162(8) require Evergy to make adjustments of its DSIM rates to reflect the amount of revenue that has been over- or under-collected. For Evergy Missouri Metro, the proposed tariff sheet increases the current residential DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00493 per kWh to \$0.00402 per kWh for residential customers. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWhs, this change will decrease the customer's bill by \$0.91 per month.

Non-residential customer impacts would be as follows:

Small General Service from \$0.00407 per kWh to \$0.00395;

Medium General Service from \$0.00554 per kWh to \$0.00602

Large General Service from \$0.00233 per kWh to \$0.00230; and

Large Power Service from \$0.00156 per kWh to \$0.00211.

For a non-residential customer using 1,000 kWh monthly, this would result in the following monthly billing changes:

Small General Service, a \$0.12 decrease;

Medium General Service, \$0.48 increase;

Large General Service, a \$0.03 decrease; and

Large Power Service, a \$0.55 increase.

For Evergy Missouri West, the proposed tariff sheet decreases the current residential DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00258 per kWh to \$0.00225 per kWh for residential customers. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWhs, this change will decrease the customer's bill by \$0.33 per month.

Non-residential customer impacts would be as follows:

Small General Service from \$0.00260 per kWh to \$0.00237;

Large General Service from \$0.00356 per kWh to \$0.00348; and

Large Power Service from \$0.00468 per kWh to \$0.00371.

For a non-residential customer using 1,000 kWh monthly, this would result in the following monthly billing changes:

Small General Service, a \$0.23 decrease;

Large General Service, a \$0.08 decrease; and

Large Power Service, a \$0.97 decrease.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4), regarding adjustment of DSIM rates between general rate proceedings, states that if the proposed adjustments are in accordance with the rule, with Section 393.1075, RSMo, and with the previously-approved DSIM, the Commission shall issue an order approving the tariff within 60 days after the tariff is filed. The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets, Staff's recommendation and attached Memoranda, and finds that the proposed tariff sheets implementing the DSIM rate adjustments are in compliance with Evergy's existing DSIM tariffs and with all applicable statutes and regulations.

So that the tariff sheets will be effective at the time requested, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Evergy Missouri Metro's tariff sheets, assigned Tracking No. JE-2025-0171, are approved to be effective August 1, 2025. The tariff sheets approved are:
