ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING FILING

On July 10, 2025,¹ the parties² filed a non-unanimous *Joint Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule* (Motion). The Motion stated that the parties reached an agreement on all issues except billing determinants and rate design and are in the process of reflecting the terms of such agreement in a formal stipulation and agreement. The Motion further requested the first week of the hearing scheduled for dates August 4 to August 15 be cancelled. The Commission ordered any party wishing to respond to the Motion to do so by July 15. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers was the only party not to have signed the Motion and it responded on July 14 indicating its support.

The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant the Motion to suspend

the remainder of the procedural schedule and to delay the hearing until August 11.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion to suspend the procedural schedule and to delay the evidentiary hearing is granted.
