## MOTION TO CORRECT TRANSCRIPT

**COME NOW** Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. ("Confluence Rivers") and Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") and, pursuant to Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.100(7), state the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as their *Motion to Correct Transcript*:

1. The hearing in this matter was held on June 26, 2025. One of the witnesses at that hearing was Mr. Stephen Kadyk. In reviewing the record of that hearing, Mr. Kadyk realized that he misspoke as to the specific MAWC systems that are currently subject to an Administrative Order on Consent ("AOC") with the Department of Natural Resources ("DNR").

2. On page 50 of the Transcript Mr. Kadyk stated as follows to the question identified

below:

Q. Mr. Kadyk, you had a question from Commissioner Mitchell about systems with compliance issues. And you mentioned two systems. Which two systems are those?

A. They are -- let me make sure I get the correct -- so they are Golden Pond and the Highlands, are the two that have AOCs at this time with the DNR.

3. Mr. Kadyk realized after the hearing and upon review that he should have indicated "they are *Stoney Creek* and the Highlands" and the applicants desire to correct the record in this regard.

4. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.100(7) states:

Suggested corrections to the transcript of record shall be offered within ten (10) days after the transcript is filed, except for good cause shown. The suggestions shall be in writing and shall be filed in the official commission file. Objections to proposed corrections shall be made in writing within ten (10) days after the filing of the suggestions. The commission shall determine what changes, if any, shall be made in the record after a review of the suggested corrections and any objections.

5. The transcript in this matter was filed on July 9, 2025. Thus, fewer than ten days

have passed. The correction identified herein should not prejudice any party and will provide an

accurate record for the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers and MAWC request the Commission grant this

motion and order such further relief as deemed appropriate in the circumstances.
