On July 8, 2015,¹ the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Leave to File Testimony in Support of Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (“motion for leave”). Staff and other parties filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement on July 7.² Staff wishes to file testimony in support of this agreement.

The Commission finds Staff’s motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any supplemental direct testimony in support of the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed on July 7, 2015 shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m., July 9, 2015.
2. Any rebuttal testimony shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m., July 15, 2015.
3. Parties shall file their position statements and an order of witnesses no later than July 16, 2015.
