The movants claim that Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) wishes to depose their witnesses in a way that would cause annoyance, embarrassment, oppression, undue burden or expense in violation of The Missouri Rules of Civil Procedure. The movants also request expedited treatment due to the hearing in this matter being scheduled to begin on July 20.

The Commission will order expedited responses.
