ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES

On November 25, 2014, Marshall Municipal Utilities and Central Missouri Electric Cooperative, Inc. (collectively, "Applicants") filed a joint application with the Commission for approval of an amendment to an approved territorial agreement. The Commission issued an order directing the Commission's Staff to file a recommendation on the application.

On January 9, 2015, Staff filed *Staff's Recommendation for Approval of Amended Territorial Agreement*. In its recommendation, Staff states that the location of the structure at issue in the application is within the service territory of Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L"). Staff states there is no indication that KCP&L was notified of the proposed amendment to the territorial agreement.

The Commission will direct that notice be provided to KCP&L and set a deadline for KCP&L and Applicants to file a response to Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
