

NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Missouri Gas Utility has requested a \$443,131 increase to its Missouri jurisdictional annual gross revenues in revised natural gas service tariff sheets filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC). This would increase residential rates by approximately 29.52%. For a residential customer using _____ Ccf in a month, the increase at the proposed rates would be approximately \$_____ per month. Missouri Gas Utility also requested a Weather Equalization Rider Adjustment to increase or decrease monthly charges from September through May to account for any deviation from normal weather.

Your comments on Missouri Gas Utility's proposed tariff changes are requested. All public comments will be considered by the PSC when deciding whether to grant or reject the tariff changes. A public comment hearing has been set before the PSC as follows:
