My name is Ken Seyer. I am a regulatory law judge with the Missouri Public Service Commission and I will preside over this portion of the hearing. The Commission has set this time for a local public hearing to give members of the public a chance to comment about the application of Environmental Utilities, LLC doing business as Golden Glade Water System. The application is for a general rate increase for water service and it is Commission case number WR, dash, 2025, dash, 0292.

The Commission regulates the rates charged by public utility companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates are just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality of service and safety of the operations of public utilities. Commissioners -- Commissioners, they're appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. The Commission employs a staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial



analysts, and other specialists in the field of utility regulation.

With us online are Chair Kayla Hahn and Commissioners Maida Coleman, Glen Kolkmeyer, and John Mitchell. The Commissioners have not made any decisions in this case and cannot answer any questions today because they have to remain impartial until after all the evidence is presented at an evidentiary hearing in this matter, should one be deemed necessary.

Chair Hahn, at this time would you like to make opening remarks?

MS. HAHN: Yes. Thank you, Judge. Apologies for the delay on the ummute. I want to welcome everyone to the hearing tonight. Appreciate you coming and letting us know if you have thoughts or feedback on this case.

At the Commission, all the Commissioners are listening intently and we take your feedback into consideration before we make any decision in the case, so on behalf of the entire commission thank you for coming to the virtual hearing tonight and we look forward to hearing from you. Thank you.
