### NOTICE REGARDING 2023 RES COMPLIANCE REPORT AND 2024-2026 COMPLIANCE PLAN

Issue Date: July 28, 2025

On April 15, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2023 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and its 2024-2026 Annual RES Standard Compliance Plan. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8) requires the Staff of the Commission to review RES compliance reports and plans and file a report of its review with the Commission within 45 days of the date of filing. The rule also provides that the Office of the Public Counsel and any other interested persons or entities may file comments based on their review of the company's RES compliance report and compliance plan within 45 days of filing with the Commission.

On April 19, 2024, the Commission issued its order directing notice of filing. Staff filed a Report for Ameren Missouri's 2025 Plan on May 30, 2024 (Report). Staff stated that the Report contained several errors, which Staff requested Ameren Missouri correct. The Report further stated that Staff has not identified any deficiencies in Ameren Missouri's 2024-2026 Compliance Plan under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(B)1.A. through G. Ameren Missouri filed a response to Staff's Report on June 18, 2024, and also filed an Amended RES Compliance Report on July 29, 2024.

The Commission issued an Order Directing Filing on July 11, 2025, giving parties the opportunity to state whether this case should remain open. The Commission received no responses.

The Commission's rule concerning RES Compliance Reports and Plans does not identify a required action the Commission is to take, except to allow the Commission to direct the utility to provide additional information or to address any concerns or deficiencies identified in the comments.<sup>1</sup> Consequently, no further action by the Commission is required, and this file shall be closed.
