## ORDER STRIKING SUBMISSIONS FROM EFIS

Issue Date: July 30, 2025

Effective Date: July 30, 2025

On July 29, 2025, Joe Wissman filed various documents and photographs in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS). Mr. Wissman is a party in a pending complaint case against Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois – Case No. EC-2025-0264 – and it appears that the documents and photographs filed on July 29 may be related to that case.

Regardless, Mr. Wissman is not a party to this case and has not been granted intervention pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075. Moreover, the documents filed on July 29<sup>th</sup> are not in substantial compliance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080 in that they are not signed;<sup>1</sup> do not include contact information;<sup>2</sup> do not display on the cover or first page of the filing the case number and title of the case;<sup>3</sup> do not include a clear and concise statement of the relief requested, a specific reference to the statutory

provision or other authority under which relief is requested, and a concise statement of the facts entitling the party to relief;<sup>4</sup> and do not include a certificate of service.<sup>5</sup>

Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(12), the Commission may reject any pleadings which are not in substantial compliance with the rule. Because Mr. Wissman is not a party and because the documents and photographs are not in substantial compliance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080, the Commission will order Mr. Wissman's July 29<sup>th</sup> submissions stricken from EFIS.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Mr. Wissman's July 29, 2025, submissions (currently EFIS Item #69) are rejected and the Commission's Data Center shall strike them from EFIS.
2. This order is effective when issued.
