- 2. Subsequently, in response to the Staff's Motion to Suspend the tariff sheets, the Commission established this case to consider the future of the Gas Supply Incentive Program ("GSIP"). On February 15, 2001, the Commission issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Further Suspending Tariff, wherein the Commission required the parties to develop and agree on a list of issues to be determined by the Commission in this case.
- 3. Pursuant to the ordered procedural schedule, Laclede submits the following list of issues:
 - (a) Should an incentive mechanism similar in structure to the Company's current Gas Supply Incentive Plan ("GSIP") be continued?

- (b) If an incentive mechanism similar in structure to the Company's current GSIP should be continued, what modifications, if any, can and should be made to the GSIP's structure?
- (c) If an incentive mechanism similar in structure to the Company's current GSIP should not be continued, what alternative can or should be implemented in its place?
