ORDER EXTENDING THE TIME TO ISSUE A RECOMMENDED REPORT AND ORDER

Issue Date: July 31, 2025

Effective Date: July 31, 2025

On April 22, 2025,¹ Complainant Leah Gay Goessling filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Based on the amount in dispute alleged by the Complainant, the Commission gave notice on April 22 that the matter would proceed under the Commission's Small Formal Complaint Case procedure.² Also on April 22, the Commission directed its Staff to investigate the Complainant's complaint and file a report no later than June 6.

On May 1, Ameren Missouri filed a *Request for Mediation*. On May 16, the Staff of the Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a notice indicating that Complainant had contacted Staff and informed Staff that she agreed to enter mediation. As the parties agreed in seeking mediation, the Commission granted the request on May 20, suspending the procedural schedule at that time.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(G) states that after affording the parties reasonable opportunity for discovery and a fair hearing, the regulatory law judge in a small formal complaint case shall issue a recommended report and order within 100 days following the filing of the complaint. However, the time period may be extended upon a finding of good cause by the regulatory law judge. The 100-day period in this case expires on July 31, 2025.

Given the parties are still participating in mediation, good cause exists to extend the time period allowed to resolve this matter. Therefore, the time period under the Commission rule to issue a recommended report and order will be extended.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(G), issuance of a recommended report and order in this matter is extended for good cause beyond one hundred (100) days following the filing of the complaint.
2. This order is effective when issued.
