## ORDER SETTING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

Issue Date: August 6, 2025

Effective Date: August 6, 2025

On July 16, 2025,<sup>1</sup> Complainant Bobby J. Armour filed a formal complaint against Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire. On July 30, Spire filed a *Motion to Dismiss* for failure to state a claim. On August 6, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a *Motion to Stay/Suspend the Order Directing Staff Investigation* stating that the amount at issue has already been litigated multiple times.<sup>2</sup>

The Commission will set a procedural conference to discuss how to proceed in this case. The procedural conference will be conducted via WebEx for the convenience of the parties.

Per Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(3), “A party may be dismissed from a case for failure to comply with any order issued by the commission, including failure to appear at any scheduled proceeding such as a public hearing, prehearing conference, hearing, or mediation session.” Further, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(7) states: “The commission, on its own motion or on the motion of a party, may after notice dismiss a

complaint for failure to state a claim on which relief may be granted or failure to comply with any provision of these rules or an order of the commission, or may strike irrelevant allegations.”

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**
