MOTION FOR COMMISSION APPROVAL OF NON-UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT AND REQUEST TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE), the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC), the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) and the Sierra Club, Missouri Coalition for the Environment, Mid-Missouri Peaceworks and the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now (collectively, the Sierra Club) and for their Motion for Commission Approval of Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and Request to Suspend Procedural Schedule, state as follows:

- 1. On November 9, 2006, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule. On December 4, 2006, AmerenUE filed the Direct Testimony of Michael L. Moehn, as required by the Procedural Schedule.
- 2. All parties in this case have engaged in and continued settlement discussions. Attached to this pleading is the agreement reached as a result of these discussions, Titled Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (Agreement). The Agreement resolves all issues among the signatory parties in this case. All parties, with

the exception of the Missouri Energy Group (MEG) and Noranda Aluminum, Inc.

(Noranda) have signed this Agreement. MEG has indicated to AmerenUE that it has no

objection to the Agreement. Noranda has indicated that it will file a statement setting

forth its position on the Agreement in a separate pleading.

3. The Agreement will result in AmerenUE making its next Chapter 22

Electric Utility Resource Planning / Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) filing on February 5,

2008, instead of December 5, 2008. It also specifies a participatory process which will be

followed during the development of AmerenUE's February 5, 2008 IRP filing. This

process will be open to all intervenors in the case, regardless of whether or not the party

is a signatory to the Agreement.

4. The signatory parties request the Commission approve the attached Non-

Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.

5. The parties respectfully request that the Commission immediately suspend

the Procedural Schedule in this case. MEG and Noranda have indicated to AmerenUE

that they have no objection to a suspension of the procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE, Staff, OPC, DNR, MIEC and the Sierra Club ask the

Commission to approve the attached Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement as a full

and final resolution of all alleged deficiencies of AmerenUE's December 5, 2005,

Electric Utility Resource Planning / IRP filing.
