Staff Recommendation on Tariff Sheets Filed to Terminate the Actual Cost Adjustment applicable to the Large Volume Transportation and Sales Service rate schedule

On March 8, 2002, the Laclede Gas Company (Laclede or Company) filed tariff sheets to terminate the Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factor that became effective November 19, 2001, and that is applicable to customers who purchase gas from the Company under the Large Volume Transportation and Sales Service (LVTSS) rate schedule. Contemporaneously, with the filing of these tariff sheets, the Company has filed a motion for expedited treatment.

The proposed revisions will eliminate the current ACA credit factor applicable to sales made under the Company's Large Volume Transportation and Sales Service (LVTSS) rate schedule.

Laclede is requesting the credit be eliminated because it is apparent that nearly the entire ACA over-collection balance that gave rise to the credit has This is due to LVTSS customers purchasing already been distributed. significantly higher than normal volumes from Laclede under the LVTSS rate schedule due to the extremely favorable price produced by the large ACA credit. As a consequence, Laclede anticipates that the ACA balance applicable to these customers will begin to reflect a substantial under-recovery of gas costs. The Company believes this will pose significant problems in the future when the Company attempts to recover this under-recovery from LVTSS customers who can avoid these charges by simply purchasing their gas from alternative sources. Laclede states in their March 8, 2002, cover letter to the Commission that:

Even if the Commission approves the expedited effective date requested in the [sic] this filing and accompanying motion, the Company conservatively estimates that by the end of this month the Company will have distributed over \$200,000 of excess credits to LVTSS sales customers.

The Commission's Energy - Tariff/Rate Design Staff has reviewed this filing and maintains that the tariff sheets have been filed in compliance with Commission rules and regulations and has no objection to the proposed changes to the ACA clause. This filing was made on ten (10) days or greater notice. Therefore,
