## ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On March 8, 2002, Laclede Gas Company issued a tariff that would terminate the Actual Cost Adjustment factor applicable to customers who purchase gas from Laclede under the Large Volume Transportation and Sales Service rate. Along with its tariff, Laclede filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment that requested that the tariff change be permitted to go into effect on March 22, 2002. Laclede indicates that larger than expected sales under the Large Volume Transportation and Sales Service rate have already exhausted the ACA credit that was reflected in that rate. A substantial under-recovery of gas costs will result if the tariff is not revised.

On March 12, 2002, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing that ordered the Staff of the Commission to file its recommendation regarding Laclede's tariff no later than March 18. That order also directed that any other party wishing to file a recommendation should do so not later than March 18.



On March 14, 2002, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation and memorandum. Staff states that the over-collection balance that gave rise to the credit that Laclede seeks to eliminate has been exhausted. As a result, Laclede will be moving into an under-recovery position. Staff agrees that the Commission should approve Laclede's tariff and thereby eliminate the credit. Staff also recommends that Laclede's tariff be approved to be effective on March 22, 2002, as requested by Laclede.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing and Staff's recommendation and memorandum and finds that Laclede's tariff filing should be approved to become effective on March 22, 2002.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Laclede Gas Company on March 8, 2002, and assigned tariff number 200200752, are approved to become effective on March 22, 2002. The tariff sheets approved are:
