ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION

On September 17, 2020, Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water), LLC applied for an accounting authority order related to COVID-19. Subsequently, the Commission directed the parties to jointly propose a procedural schedule by December 23, 2020. On December 21, 2020, Missouri Water requested an extension of time until January 8, 2021, to submit a jointly proposed procedural schedule. Missouri Water cites ongoing settlement discussions and the press of other business as well as seasonal holidays in support of its request.

Missouri Water stated that it contacted the other parties and none objected to its requested extension. Based on the representation of counsel, the Commission will consider the request for additional time unopposed. The Commission finds that the unopposed request for additional time is reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than January 8, 2021, the parties shall submit a joint proposed schedule or a status update.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
