- witness Matthew Daunis and also to confirm with the Commission the importance of the

- 16 Q. IN COOPERATION WITH YOUR OFFICE IS AQUILA PRESENTLY INVOLVED IN

- 19 2004-0034 filed a Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement addressing issues related to the
- case. This stipulation was approved by the Commission effective April 22, 2004. In that
- stipulation Aquila agreed to fund through shareholder funds, on an annual basis and until
- the next general rate proceeding involving its Missouri electric rates, \$93,500 that may be
- used for a low-income weatherization program that is consistent with federal

1		weatherization assistance program guidelines, commercial energy audit and/or Change-
2		A-Light program. Aquila implemented that program and it is underway.
3		
4	Q.	HAVE THERE BEEN ANY PROBLEMS WITH THE PROGRAM.
5	A.	I can identify only two: Aquila should be more active in the application process for low
6		income weatherization assistance and the other is that the program is woefully
7		underfunded. Other than these, I think the program is becoming very effective and I join
8		Anita Randolph of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and Lena Mantle of the
9		Commission staff in highly recommending that Aquila continue to fund this program.
10		Aquila continues to benefit from similar programs funded by other area utilities and it is
11		entirely fair for Aquila to itself fund such a program. Continuation of this program is
12		most important.
13		
14	Q.	IS THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY PREPARED TO DISCUSS MS. RANDOLPH'S
15		RECOMMENDATIONS AND OTHER PROGRAMS TO BENEFIT ELIBIGLE
16		CUSTOMERS?
17	A.	Yes, as Mr. Daunis suggests to the parties at page 3 of his testimony, the City is willing
18		to continue discussions on energy efficiency programs, but I want to make clear that
19		Aquila should continue its funding for the program it implemented under the Stipulation,
20		and at greater levels, while those discussions are ongoing.
