INVITATION TO FILE COMMENTS **REGARDING COSTS OF COMPLIANCE**

Section 536.200.3, RSMo (Supp. 2020), requires the Commission to review the fiscal note that it attached to its 2019 rescission of Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.145 and 3.185, amendment of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.070,¹ and adoption of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.105² at the end of the first full fiscal year following the implementation of the rules.

As part of its review, the Commission's Staff filed a motion on May 26, 2021, asking the Commission to invite interested stakeholders to offer comments about the accuracy of the fiscal impact stated in the fiscal notes that accompanied the rulemakings. The Commission will do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Comments regarding the actual cost of compliance shall be filed with the Commission by July 23, 2021.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all persons who filed comments regarding the rules.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
