#### PROTECTIVE ORDER

Issue Date: August 20, 2025 Effective Date: August 20, 2025

On June 26, 2025,<sup>1</sup> Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for an 800-megawatt multi-unit simple cycle natural gas electric generation facility and a 400-megawatt battery storage facility on the former site of Ameren Missouri's Rush Island Energy Center. On the same day, Ameren Missouri also filed a *Motion for Protective Order*, requesting a protective order under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135 allowing it to designate certain information as "highly confidential". On August 11, Ameren Missouri filed an *Amended Motion for Protective Order* (Amended Motion).

The Amended Motion explained that the information sought to be protected includes responses to various various bid specifications, responses to requests for proposals, and Ameren Missouri's analyses of these responses. Other information sought to be protected incuded certain agreements (and documents reflecting the terms of such agreements) regarding the projects, and testimony regarding the specific terms and conditions, various cost and pricing information. The Amended Motion also stated that

the industrial customer market is an extremely competitive forum where information regarding customer pricing, supply costs, business relationships, market data, and other proprietary data are closely guarded trade secrets, and that many industrial customer contracts contain confidentiality provisions. The Amended Motion included exemplar disclosure forms for access to both confidential and highly confidential information.

The Commission set a time for responses to Ameren Missouri's Amended Motion.

No responses were received.

The Commission finds the Amended Motion reasonable and will grant it.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Ameren Missouri's request for a protective order is granted as follows;
  - a. Materials and information divulged by Ameren Missouri or shall be considered to be "Highly Confidential" if so designated at the time of disclosure.
  - b. With regard to entities and individuals other than the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel:
    - i. Disclosure of materials or information so designated shall be made only to attorneys and/or to such outside consultants who have executed a Commission Nondisclosure Agreement. No Highly Confidential information shall be provided directly or indirectly to any non-attorney party employee or other individual.
    - ii. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "Highly Confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to the case referenced above and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of the protective order.
    - iii. All material and information designated as "Highly Confidential" in the possession of any entity or person, as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be

returned to the designating party or destroyed upon the conclusion of the referenced case.

- c. If a party disagrees with the "Highly Confidential" designation of any information, the party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(8). If the party exhausts these dispute resolution procedures, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.
- 2. All persons authorized to access "Confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
- 3. All persons authorized to access "Highly Confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit B.
  - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
