On June 30, 2015¹, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a Motion for Leave to File Testimony in Support of Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (“motion for leave”). The Staff of the Commission replied on July 6, stating that it does not object to the motion. Staff also moves the Commission to set dates for filing rebuttal testimony, position statements, and an order of witnesses, since the hearing is scheduled to begin on July 20.

The Commission finds Ameren Missouri’s motion for leave reasonable, and will grant it. The Commission finds Staff’s requests reasonable, and will grant them.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Leave to File Testimony in Support of Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri is granted.
2. Any rebuttal testimony shall be filed no later than July 15, 2015.

3. Parties shall file their position statements and an order of witnesses no later than July 16, 2015.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
