MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of MAWC’s tariff sheets filed on April 30, 2015:

1. On April 14, 2015, the Commission issued its Order Approving Application For Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, effective April 24, 2015. MAWC currently plans to close on its purchase of the sewer system that is the subject of this matter on May 22, 2015.
2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, MAWC has filed sewer tariff sheets consistent with the Commission’s Order Approving Application For Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. These tariff sheets carry proposed effective dates of May 30, 2015 (30 days), and have been assigned tracking number YS-2015-0319.
3. MAWC hereby seeks the Commission’s order allowing the proposed tariff sheets to go into effect on May 22, 2015 (the date of closing), less than thirty days notice.
4. A grant of this motion will further the public interest. As indicated above, the subject transaction will be closed on May 22, 2015. Thus, as of that date, MAWC will own and operate the subject sewer system. The subject tariff sheets are intended to clarify the rates, rules and regulations that will apply to the applicable customers on a going-forward basis. Addressing
