The Commission has set this time for a local public hearing to give members of the public a chance to comment about the Application of Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Relating to a Transmission Line and Associated Facilities in Perry County, which is Commission Case No. EA-2025-0222.

The Commission regulates the rates charged by public utility companies in Missouri to ensure that those rates are just and reasonable. The Commission also regulates the quality of service and the safety of the operations of public utilities.

The Commission has five Commissioners, although there is currently a vacancy. They are appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate. The Commission employs a staff of engineers, accountants, attorneys, financial analysts, and other specialists in the field of utility regulation.
