## STAFF'S STATUS REPORT AND MOTION FOR EXTENSION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and states:

- 1. On July 10, 2025,<sup>1</sup> Edwin Mahr filed a complaint against Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC").
- 2. On July 11, the Commission issued its Order Giving Notice of Complaint and Directing Response. The Commission directed Staff to file a Report no later than August 25.
  - 3. On August 8, MAWC filed a Request for Mediation.
- 4. The Commission has issued no order granting the Request for Mediation, nor has Complainant filed a pleading consenting or objecting to mediation.
- 5. Staff is advised that MAWC and Mr. Mahr are in discussion and that MAWC believes that the parties have reached an agreement in principle. Staff is advised that the parties are drafting documents to memorialize the agreement. In these circumstances, MAWC has requested a deadline extension for answering Staff's data requests, and Staff

has consented. In this context, MAWC agreed to a deadline extension on Staff's recommendation.

6. The Commission would note that the Commission has not actually ordered Staff to file a recommendation for case disposition.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will accept this Report as compliant with the Commission's order; its order extending any deadline for Staff's recommendation until such time as MAWC has filed a status report or other pleading; and its order requiring MAWC to file a status report or other pleading by a deadline which the Commission shall set.
