**STAFF RECOMMENDATION FOR APPROVAL OF
COMPLIANCE TARIFF SHEETS**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through undersigned counsel, and for its recommendation states as follows:

1. On October 31, 2017, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO")(collectively the "Companies") filed revised tariff sheets to reflect revisions agreed upon in the *Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Cycle 2 Transition Plan For Certain Long-Lead Projects and Special Provisions for Income-Eligible Multi-Family Program Under the MEEIA Cycle 2 Program Plan* ("Stipulation") as filed on October 2, 2017, and approved by the Commission's October 19th *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement* ("Order").

2. On November 1, 2017 the Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing of Staff Recommendation Regarding Revised Tariffs* directing Staff to file its recommendation not later than November 14, 2017.

3. The Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff sheet revisions and determined that the revised tariff sheets are in compliance with the Stipulation and the

Commission's Order as more fully explained in Staff's Memorandum attached hereto as "Appendix A" and incorporated herein. Accordingly as a result of its review the Staff recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheets filed by the Companies to go into effect on November 30, 2017, the requested effective date.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Staff respectfully requests the Commission approve the following tariff sheets to become effective November 30, 2017:

SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation for Approval of Tariff Sheet Revisions for Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company

DATE: November 9, 2017

On October 31, 2017, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) (collectively “Companies”), filed with the Commission revised tariff sheets to reflect revisions to the *Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Cycle 2 Transition Plan For Certain Long-Lead Projects and Special Provisions for Income-Eligible Multi-Family Program Under the MEEIA Cycle 2 Program Plan* (“Stipulation”)¹ filed on October 2, 2017 and approved in the Commission’s *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement* filed on October 19, 2017.²

The revised tariff sheets filed by the Companies add the definition of Long-Lead Project and modify the definition of Program Period as agreed to by the parties to the Stipulation. The special provisions for the Companies’ Income-Eligible Multi-Family Programs do not require approval by the Commission and will be addressed through the 11-step change process outlined in the Companies’ tariff sheets.³

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Commission Staff (“Staff”) has reviewed the tariff sheet revisions filed by the Companies and determined that the revised tariff sheets are in compliance with the *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement*. Therefore Staff recommends the Commission approve the following revised tariff sheets as filed on October 31, 2017 to go into effect for service on the requested effective date of November 30, 2017:




