ORDER REGARDING RESPONSE TIME FOR DATA REQUESTS

Issue Date: August 26, 2025 Effective Date: August 26, 2025

On August 19, 2025,¹ the Commission held a procedural conference with the parties in order to discuss scheduling an evidentiary hearing date. At the conference, counsel for Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) requested that the Commission modify the procedural schedule to expand the response time for data requests if the hearing date were to be delayed. On August 21, the Commission rescheduled the hearing from September 26 to October 27.

The procedural schedule currently states "After the due date for filing of Direct testimony (July 17, 2025) and before the due date for filing of Surrebuttal testimony (August 28, 2025), the response time for data requests shall be ten calendar days to provide the requested information, and five business days to object or notify that more than ten calendar days will be needed to provide the requested information. After the due date for filing of Surrebuttal testimony (August 28, 2025), the response time for data requests shall be five business days to provide the requested information, and two business days to object or notify that more than five calendar days will be needed to

provide the requested information." Counsel for ATXI requested that the time for data request responses between the due date for Direct testimony and the due date for Surrebuttal testimony continue through the end of the request period. The procedural schedule states that September 4 is the last day to request discovery. No parties objected to this request.

The Commission granted this request at the procedural conference. Accordingly, the Commission will formalize that direction to the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- ATXI's request for an expansion to the response time for data requests is granted.
- 2. From August 28, 2025 through September 4, 2025, the response time for data requests shall be ten calendar days to provide the requested information, and five business days to object or notify that more than ten calendar days will be needed to provide the requested information.
 - This order is effective when issued.
