**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF APPLICATION, ESTABLISHING
INTERVENTION FILING DATE, AND SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL
CONFERENCE**

On August 28, 2015, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) applied to the Commission for approval of Demand-Side Programs and for authority to establish a Demand-Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) as contemplated by the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) and the Commission’s implementing regulations. The Commission will provide notice of GMO’s application to potentially interested individuals and entities and will invite them to apply to intervene as parties.

As GMO’s application explains, the Commission’s rule requires the Commission to act on that application within 120 days, which in this case is December 26, 2015, although GMO is requesting an order by December 14, 2015. Therefore, the Commission will require applications to intervene to be filed quickly.¹ The Commission will also schedule a procedural conference at which the parties may discuss how the Commission should best proceed to consider GMO’s application.

¹ Potential parties should be aware that even if they do not file their application to intervene within the time set by this order, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(10) allows the Commission to accept late-filed applications to intervene upon a showing of good cause to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each party to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's most recent triennial IRP case (EO-2015-0252), and to the county commission of each county within KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area.

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing the counties within KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area, and to the news media serving that service area.

3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than September 14, 2015.

4. Any party wishing to respond to any application to intervene shall do so no later than September 21, 2015.

5. A procedural conference is scheduled for September 23, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. in Room 305 at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 6. This order shall be effective when issued.
