### ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

Issue Date: December 31, 2020 Effective Date: December 31, 2020

On December 30, 2020, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority to provide basic local, local exchange, exchange access, and interexchange services of Logix Communications, LP d/b/a Logix Communications (Company). On September 24, 2002, the Commission granted the certificate of service authority at issue in File No. LA-2003-0027. The Staff's motion states that the Company wishes to voluntarily relinquish its authority. The Company has two applicable tariffs that it also requested be cancelled, YL-2006-0871 and YL-2006-0872.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.
