## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On August 29, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to Section 393.170.1, RSMo. The CCN would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage a 250-megawatt (MW) solar generation facility to be constructed in Callaway County, Missouri (the Reform Solar Project), including a 345 kV switching station (the Odyssey Switching Station) to which the Reform Solar Project will connect to the existing 345 kV transmission system. Ameren Missouri is also requesting a variance from the requirements in 20 CSR 4240-20.045(3)(C) and (6)(J), and requests a Commission order by March 2026.

The Commission will provide notice of the application to the general public and interested parties and set a deadline for intervention requests.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Callaway County, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice available to the media serving Callaway County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than September 19, 2025. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission.

4. No later than October 3, 2025, the Commission's Staff shall file a Recommendation or an alternative pleading.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
