## NOTICE OF DEFICIENCIES IN APPLICATION

Issue Date: September 9, 2025

On September 8, 2025, Pro Energy Partners, LLP filed an application for certification as a seller of energy services in the State of Missouri. The application is signed by Jarrett Rogers, President of Pro Energy Partners, LLP. Mr. Rogers is not identified as an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri or any other state.

Missouri statute, Section 484.020, RSMo (2016), restricts the practice of law to licensed attorneys. Consequently, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(1) requires pleadings filed with the Commission to be signed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri. However, 20 CSR 4240-2.040(5) allows representation by non-attorneys only if the non-attorney is a natural person acting solely on his or her own behalf and representing only him or herself.<sup>1</sup>

Additionally, the application indicates that the applicant is a partnership. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.060(1)(D) requires that any application filed with the commission on behalf of a partnership include a copy of the partnership agreement. The application did not include a copy of the partnership agreement of Pro Energy Partners, LLP.

Pro Energy Partners, LLP's filing is deficient and the Commission cannot take action on the application until the two deficiencies are corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until October 9, 2025, to allow Pro Energy Partners, LLP to correct the deficiencies – both of representation by an attorney licensed in Missouri, and the filing of the partnership agreement. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the filing and close the file.
