## STAFF'S TARIFF RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Tariff Recommendation* states as follows:

- 1. On August 29, 2025, The Empire District Gas Company d/b/a Liberty ("Empire") filed proposed revisions to its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider ("WNAR") tariff sheet assigned Tracking Number JG-2026-0026.
- 2. Accompanying this pleading, and incorporated herein by reference, is Staff's Memorandum recommending Commission approval of the WNAR rates Empire filed in its August 29, 2025, tariff sheet.
- 3. The effect of Empire's WNAR tariff sheet filing means that residential customers of Empire who used 100 Ccf<sup>1</sup> of natural gas in a given billing month would see an approximate \$1.65 bill decrease compared to the currently effective rate, and small general service class customers using 100 Ccf of gas will see an approximately \$1.34 bill decrease in their bill compared to the currently effective rate.
- 4. Staff has verified that Empire has filed its Annual Report. Staff is not aware of any other matter pending before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing.

  Due to the expedited nature of the review, Staff's recommendation is based on a limited

review of the application and supporting materials. Staff further recommends the tariff language be revisited and revised if needed during the next rate case to allow longer processing time sufficient for all parties.

5. Staff recommends approval of the filed tariff sheet in Tracking No. JG-2026-0026, as follows:

WHEREFORE, as set forth in Staff's Memorandum, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order approving Empire's WNAR tariff sheet to go into effect on October 1, 2025.

**DATE:** September 15, 2025

On August 29, 2025, The Empire District Gas Company d/b/a Liberty ("Empire") filed a tariff sheet designed to reflect the annual adjustment made pursuant to the Company's Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider ("WNAR") with a requested effective date of October 1, 2025. On September 2, 2025, the Commission directed Staff to file a recommendation regarding the WNAR Tariff Sheet in Tariff Tracking No. JG-2026-0026 no later than September 15, 2025. The WNAR is applicable only to the Residential and Small General Service rate classes. After its review, Staff recommends approval of the tariff sheet in Tracking No. JG-2026-0026.

Empire's WNAR became effective August 17, 2020. The purpose of the tariff is to reflect the annual adjustment made pursuant to the Empire's WNAR for the twelve-month period ending September 30, 2026. Empire calculated the rates annually to account for variations in temperature based on the difference between the actual heating degree days and the normalized heating degree days. Empire's current and proposed rates are included in Table 1 below.

Based on weather variations in Empire's service districts, proposed Residential and Small General

Service class WNAR rates for the Empire district service areas will be applied as a separate line

item and will increase a customer's overall bill. However, a residential customer using 100 Ccf of

natural gas in a given billing month would see a decrease of approximately \$1.65 compared to the

currently effective WNAR rate. Likewise, a small general service class customer using 100 Ccf of

gas would see a decrease of approximately \$1.34 compared to the currently effective WNAR rate.
