ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On August 29, 2025,¹ Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity with the Commission to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage a solar generation facility in Callaway County, Missouri. Subsequently, the Commission set a time for applications to intervene.

On September 2, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri timely filed an application to intervene. Renew Missouri stated that it is a non-profit policy group whose mission is to transform Missouri into a leading state in renewable energy and energy efficiency. Renew Missouri stated its interests are different than those of the general public. Renew Missouri further stated that granting its intervention request would serve the public interest. Renew Missouri did not provide a position regarding the application but stated it expects to provide a position after reviewing the application further and forthcoming discovery.

More than ten days have passed since the filing of Renew Missouri's application to intervene and no one has responded.² After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri has interests which are different from that of the general public and also that allowing it to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application to intervene of Renew Missouri is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
