## ORDER APPROVING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

Issue Date: September 29, 2025

Effective Date: October 9, 2025

This order approves a negotiated Interconnection Agreement between the parties, which was filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, LLC d/b/a AT&T Missouri.

On July 22, 2025, AT&T Missouri filed an application with the Commission for approval of a negotiated Interconnection Agreement (the Agreement) with Unite Private Networks, LLC d/b/a Segra under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). AT&T Missouri is certified with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange carrier and interconnected voice over internet protocol service provider. Segra is certificated with the Commission as a competitive local exchange, interexchange carrier and interconnected voice over internet protocol service provider.

Although Segra is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. On August 13, 2025, the Commission issued an order making Segra a party in this case and directed any party wishing to request a hearing to do so no later than August 28, 2025. No requests for hearing were filed.

Under Section 252(e) of the Act, any Interconnection Agreement adopted by negotiation must be submitted to the Commission for approval. The Commission may reject

an Agreement if it finds that the Agreement is discriminatory or that it is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

On September 12, 2025, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a recommendation. Staff recommended that the Agreement be approved and noted that the Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act in that it is not discriminatory toward nonparties and is not against the public interest.

The Commission has considered the application, the supporting documentation, and Staff's recommendation. Based upon that review, the Commission finds that the Agreement meets the requirements of the Act in that it does not discriminate against a nonparty carrier and implementation of the Agreement is not inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

So that the parties may proceed under the terms of the Agreement without further delay, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Interconnection Agreement between AT&T Missouri and Segra, filed on July 22, 2025, is approved.
2. This order shall become effective on October 9, 2025.
3. This case may be closed on October 10, 2025.
