**STATUS REPORT AND REQUEST FOR LEAVE
TO FILE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Status Report and Request for Leave to File Procedural Schedule*, states as follows:

1. On August 29, 2025, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren”) filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage solar generation facilities, including a switching station for the connection of the Reform Solar Project, in Callaway County, Missouri.

2. On September 2, 2025, the Commission ordered Staff to either file a recommendation or alternative pleading regarding Ameren’s application by October 3, 2025. This report and request serves as Staff’s alternative pleading.

3. The parties¹ in this case desire a procedural schedule in this matter similar to those ordered in EA-2024-0237 and EA-2025-0238. As such, Staff believes additional time is necessary in order to coordinate with all parties.

¹ At the time of this filing Staff had yet to hear from Sierra Club. Ameren, the Office of Public Counsel and Renew Missouri are in agreement to develop a joint proposed procedural schedule.

4. If so ordered, the parties who have agreed to develop a procedural schedule endeavor to file such by October 14, 2025.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Status Report and Request for Leave to File Procedural Schedule* and prays the Commission order said proposed schedule to be filed on or before October 14, 2025.
