On August 29, 2025,¹ Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity with the Commission to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage a solar generation facility in Callaway County, Missouri. Subsequently, the Commission ordered the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file either a recommendation or alternative pleading regarding Ameren Missouri's application by October 3.

On October 3, Staff filed its *Status Report and Request for Leave to File Procedural Schedule* requesting a deadline of October 14.

The Commission finds this request reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's request for leave to file a procedural schedule is granted.
2. No later than October 14, 2025, Staff shall file, on behalf of all the parties, a joint proposed procedural schedule.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.

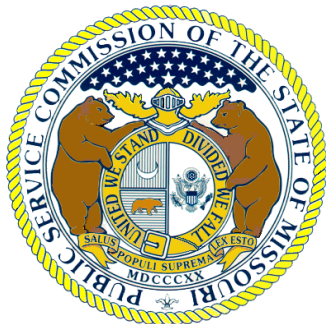
