UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND BRIEFING SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and for its Motion to Amend Briefing Schedule, states as follows:

1. In its October 2, 2025, *Briefing Schedule Order*, the Commission set a due date for Initial Briefs of October 20, 2025, and for Reply Briefs of October 27, 2025. Vol. 3, Unofficial Transcript of Proceedings, p. 295, ll. 6-8. Those dates were discussed on-the-record near the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing. *Id.* p. 207, l. 20 to p. 298, l. 4.

2. The Commission posted the just-referenced Unofficial Transcript in the late afternoon on October 10, 2025. The current briefing deadlines were premised on final transcripts being available on October 8, 2025. *Id.* p. 295, ll. 6-8.

3. Given the extensive record in this case and the large number of issues for resolution (consisting of 21 separate issues, plus subparts on some issues), it is especially important that the parties be able to prepare and file well-organized, clear, and comprehensive briefs to aid the Commission in its deliberations.

4. Typically, Initial Briefs are generally due approximately two weeks after final hearing transcripts are available to facilitate the briefing process. Under the current briefing schedule, there are only seven calendar days remaining to prepare and file Initial Briefs.

5. Ameren Missouri respectfully submits that this time interval is insufficient to properly prepare briefs and shared those concerns with all parties, proposing to modify the current briefing schedule so that the Initial Briefs would be due October 24, 2025, and Reply Briefs would be due October 31, 2025. This will allow two weeks post-the availability of the Unofficial Transcripts and, based on Ameren Missouri's understanding that final transcripts will be available on October 14, 2025, eleven days post-finalization of the transcripts. As noted, Ameren Missouri respectfully suggests that such time is needed to properly prepare briefs in this case.

6. Counsel for all parties have indicated to the undersigned counsel for Ameren Missouri that they do not oppose Ameren Missouri's recommended changes to the briefing schedule.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests that the briefing schedule in this case be amended to establish a deadline of October 24, 2025, for the filing of Initial Briefs, and October 31, 2025, for the filing of Reply Briefs.
