REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Request for Extension of Time*, states as follows:

1. On August 29, 2025, Ameren filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage solar generation facilities, including a switching station for the connection of the Reform Solar Project, in Callaway County, Missouri.

2. On October 3, 2025, the Commission ordered Staff to file, on behalf of all parties, a proposed procedural schedule by October 14, 2025. The Parties in this case desire a procedural schedule in this matter similar to those ordered in EA-2024-0237 and EA-2025-0238. The parties have encountered major scheduling conflicts with other matters and the time frame desired for this case. The Parties have communicated at great lengths to reach agreement but have yet been able to coordinate a full procedural schedule. As such, Staff believes additional time is necessary to coordinate with all parties and party witnesses to create a schedule that will work for all those involved.

3. Staff requests an additional two weeks to coordinate with the Parties. Staff will endeavor to file a Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule by October 28th, 2025.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Request for Extension of Time* and prays the Commission grant this request and order said proposed schedule to be filed on or before October 28, 2025.
