STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and for its Staff Recommendation about Evergy Missouri West’s tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JE-2025-0079 respectfully states as follows:

1. On November 25, 2024, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (“EMW” or “Company”), submitted revised tariff sheets for the Company’s first annual true-up of Securitized Utility Tariff Rider (“SUR”) tariff sheets PSC MO No. 1, 2nd Revised Sheet No. 168.2 and PSC MO No. 1, 2nd Revised Sheet No. 168.5, with an effective date of December 25, 2024.

2. On November 26, 2024, the Commission issued an *Order Directing a Staff Tariff Recommendation and Setting Time for Responses* concerning EMW’s proposed tariff revisions, ordering Staff to file its recommendation on the tariff sheets¹ no later than December 6, 2024.

3. As discussed in more detail and reflected in the Staff Recommendation Memorandum which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, Staff has reviewed the Company’s filing pursuant to the applicable statute, § 393.1700.2(3)(e), RSMo., and recommends the Commission approve the following tariff sheets, originally

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On November 25, 2024, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. (“EMW” or “Company”) submitted revised tariff sheets for the Company’s first annual true-up of Securitized Utility Tariff Rider (“SUR”), tariff sheets P.S.C. MO No. 1, 2nd Revised Sheet No. 168.2 and P.S.C. MO No. 1, 2nd Revised Sheet No. 168.5, with an effective date of December 25, 2024.

On November 26, 2024, the Commission issued its Order Directing a Staff Tariff Recommendation and Setting Time for Responses about EMW’s Tariff Revision, ordering Staff to file its recommendation on the tariff sheets¹ no later than December 6, 2024.

BACKGROUND

On March 11, 2022, EMW filed a verified petition for a financing order seeking authority to issue securitized utility tariff bonds regarding the extraordinary costs incurred by the Company during Winter Storm Uri. That petition was assigned Missouri Public Service Commission (“the Commission”) File No. EF-2022-0155.

On November 17, 2022, the Commission issued its *Amended Report and Order*, approving the Company’s petition to issue securitized utility tariff bonds. The Commission also ordered EMW to file true-ups annually. The Commission stated on page 93 of the *Amended Report and Order* that “True-up filings will be incorporated into the next recovery period based upon the cumulative differences, regardless of the reason, between the total securitized revenue requirement (including scheduled principal of and interest payments on the securitized utility tariff bonds) designed to be recovered during the current recovery period and the amount of securitized utility tariff charge remittances to the indenture trustee received during the current recovery period from application of the current rate then in effect.”

STAFF REVIEW

Section 393.1700.2(3)(e), RSMo. states in part:

If the commission issues a financing order, the electrical corporation shall file with the commission at least annually a petition or a letter applying the formula-based true-up mechanism and, based on estimates of consumption for each rate class and other mathematical factors, requesting administrative approval to make the applicable adjustments. The review of the filing shall be limited to determining whether there are any mathematical or clerical errors in the application of the formula-based true-up mechanism relating to the appropriate amount of any overcollection or undercollection of securitized utility tariff charges and the amount of an adjustment.

Staff has reviewed the workpapers for mathematical or clerical errors in the calculation of the securitized utility tariff rider. Staff also reviewed the Amended Report and Order in this case to ensure compliance with the order and invoices provided by the Company for the ongoing financing costs.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Commission approve the following tariff sheets, originally filed on November 25, 2024 to go into effect on and after December 25, 2024, the requested effective date:
